#### **GYPSY'S FEATURES**

Capturing an actor's motion with the Gypsy Motion Capture System is very simple install the capture board and software, put on the Gypsy mocap suit, measure the distances between the actor's joints and suit offsets, and start capturing motion. The Gypsy can drive real-time rendered characters for live performance or post-processed animation via the Kaydara FiLMBOX. Data can also be saved as a BVH file and imported into any 3D-animation program such as 3D Studio MAX, LightWave 3D, Maya and Softimage.

The Gypsy Motion Capture System is free of magnetic interference and optical occlusion and offers easy simultaneous capture of multiple actors. Users can experience real-time playback without the need for postprocessing to see motion data.

#### Additional features of the Gypsy include:

- 42 sensors capable of sensing 16 joints
- Precise rotation calculations of an actor's joints

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- 60 ft. range, with greater distances supported through longer cables
- User-selectable, real-time capture rate of up to 120 fps
- Rotational accuracy of .08 degrees
- BVH support for 3D Studio MAX, Character Studio, Maya, Softimage, LightWave 3D, Life Forms Studio, Poser, Kaydara FiLMBOX, Mirai, and other high-end 3D animation software programs.

#### PRICING AND AVAILABILITY

The Gypsy 2.5 is currently shipping and has a SRP of \$25,000 (US); international pricing varies. An SDK for C++ programming is also included with the system and software drivers for Kaydara FiLMBOX, 3D Studio MAX, Maya, Movido, and Typhoon are available.
